

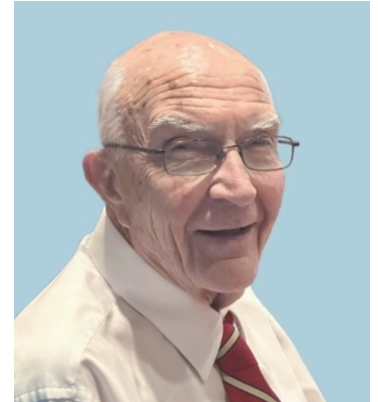

Testimony of Doctor James Masloff

(Below is what Dr. Jim had written sometime in 2022 and was printed in the program for his celebration of Life, which took place on March 14th, 2026, at First Baptist Church of Charlottesville. Jim served as MLI's Medical Director for over 24 years. We will continue to serve the least of these of East Africa in Memory of our dear friend.)

Having reached 90 years of age, my earthly life will soon end. When I take my last breath, I know I will be passing directly into the eternal presence of Jesus Christ. I know this not because of any good deeds I have done on earth but because I have claimed Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. I send this letter because I want all of my family to be with me in heaven. Below is presented God's plan of Salvation.



When Adam and Eve initially dwelt with God in the Garden of Eden they lived in perfect harmony. Then they rebelled against God and this relationship was broken. Since then, all of mankind is born with a sinful and selfish nature. To restore that relationship God sent His Son, Jesus Christ. He walked the earth showing the kind of life to which we should aspire. At the end of His earthly life, He, the sinless Son of God, went to the Cross where He died paying for our sin debt and imputing His righteousness to all who repent of their sins and claim Him as their Lord and Savior. It is my prayer for all of those who have not claimed this blessing would do so. It is the greatest gift you can ever receive.

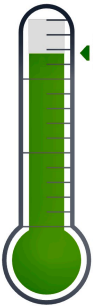

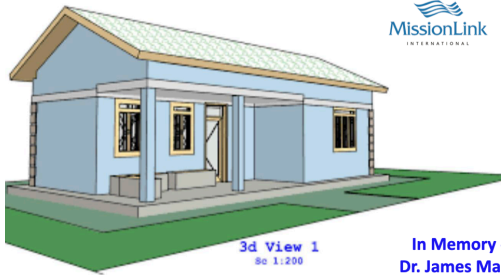

Upcoming Uganda Trip

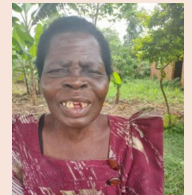

MLU CHRISTIAN STUDY CENTERS: Our **#1 objective** is to **make disciples that make disciples**. Donations help us to continue this work. We now have multiple schools with students enrolled across Uganda for the purpose of training new pastors/church leaders to expand the Kingdom of God in their nation.

KENYA - BUDGET NEEDS

SOUTHVILLE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL: This Primary school managed by Pastor Anthony Ndambuki in Eldoret has 200 students and focuses on educating with a biblical worldview. This school needs monthly support for teaching staff, feeding all the children, and basic school supplies.

Classroom Project: The primary school has Pre-K through 6th-grade but is lacking 7th-grade classrooms to allow the children to graduate from Southville and move directly into Secondary (High School). We are seeking donors willing to help us build 3 Classrooms for only **\$16,000 USD**.

PASTOR EUTICAULS WAMBUA: Pastor Euticauls oversees several schools, has planted numerous churches, and pastors Baptist Chapel church in Nairobi. Our brother is working on planting more churches within Kenya. Any gifts of support would help tremendously and be appreciated.
