The Power of Forgiveness

orgiveness is one of the most powerful and transformative acts a person can experience and extend. At the heart of the Christian faith lies the message of forgiveness—both the forgiveness we receive from God and the forgiveness we are called to offer others. The Bible presents forgiveness not as a suggestion, but as a command rooted in love, grace, and the redemptive work of Christ.



Jesus emphasized the necessity of forgiveness in His teachings. In Matthew 6:14–15, He says, "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father

forgive your trespasses." This highlights that our willingness to forgive directly affects our relationship with God. It is not merely an emotional act, but a spiritual obligation that demonstrates our understanding of the mercy we have received.

One of the most powerful examples of forgiveness in Scripture is Jesus on the cross. As He was being crucified, He prayed, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." (Luke 23:34). Even while enduring the most severe pain, in agony, Jesus chose forgiveness. His example shows that forgiveness is not dependent on the actions or remorse of others, but on our decision to reflect God's grace. Of course, the strength to focus on others while we ourselves are suffering comes not by us alone. This remains also an act of God by choosing obedient and willing servants to extend His mercy and grace.

Forgiveness also has liberating power. Harboring resentment and bitterness weighs down the soul. Hebrews 12:15 warns, "See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God; that no "root of bitterness" springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled." Letting go of offenses frees us to live in peace, unchained by past hurts. In fact, holding on to something someone either said or did only stirs up fruits of the flesh, including anger, that brings destruction. We learn in James 1:20, "for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God."

The apostle Paul echoes this in *Ephesians 4:32*: "And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you." Our capacity to forgive flows from the forgiveness we have received in Christ. It reflects God's heart and brings healing—not only to relationships but to our own hearts. We are then true ambassadors for Christ as we are never more like Him than when we choose to love others through forgiveness.

In conclusion, forgiveness is a divine act that holds power to restore, renew, and release. It is both a **gift we receive** and a **grace we give**. As we embrace God's forgiveness, we are empowered to extend it, becoming agents of reconciliation in a broken world. Let's GO in Grace!

MLU CHRISTIAN STUDY CENTERS: Our #1 objective is to *make disciples that make disciples*. Donations help us to continue this work. We now have <u>multiple schools</u> with students enrolled across Uganda for the purpose of training new pastors/church leaders to help multiply the Kingdom of God in their villages, nation, and world.
