Resigning, yet remaining an active part of the mission. The following is the resignation letter submitted to our Mission Link Intl. board from Dr. Rick and Candy Sadler, MLI's Founder and President Emeritus.

Dear Mission Link International Board Members:

The vision for Mission Link International began when visiting Uganda, East Africa, in the summer of 1996. A year later, a mission began to reach East Africa for Jesus Christ and other countries worldwide. For many years, we developed satellite ministries. The most successful satellite was in Nepal, with Janice Viren, who lived in Montana. As a result, a large orphanage and a training school for pastors were established in the West. After many years of traveling to various countries (Peru, Haiti, Guatemala, Nicaragua, Honduras, India, Myanmar (Burma), Nepal, & Ukraine), it was apparent that MLI needed to concentrate/focus on East Africa. Our main frontline ministry has been Making Disciples -- Matthew 28:18-20. Over the years, we have seen many discipled (trained), and some pastors even saved, in Uganda and Tanzania. Our primary goal has been to equip nationals (Africans) to reach their country for Jesus Christ.

In time, we established a widow's ministry in Africa (a widow's ministry was my DMin. Thesis). Though Ugandan widows were initially skeptical due to many illegitimate African ministries, they soon developed trust in MLI. Being afforded a 4-5 months stay in Uganda each year, caring relationships developed with widows. Consequently, there are over 80 widows supported by donors. In addition, MLI is assisting: Street-Kids, a Deaf School, Albinos, Medical Missions, Church Planting, Food Distribution, Hosting Teams, etc. MLI has also been very good to their staff by improving their standard of living (wages, houses, vehicles, medical, schooling, etc.) After speaking at an IMB/SBC Conference in Brackenhurst, Kenya (2002), MLI began linking with ministries in Kenya—presently Nairobi and Eldoret.

No one person can take credit for any ministry. It has been the work of God utilizing His people. MLI's Board has been the impetus and backbone of all we have accomplished over the years. I am very grateful for a Board that has contributed and sacrificed their time, energy, and resources. Working with a dedicated, sacrificial, and godly team has been a tremendous privilege.

Candy (my extraordinary/dedicated/sacrificial partner in ministry) and I have enjoyed serving on the Board of MLI for many years. Though our love for Mission LINK is ginormous, it must continue and live/thrive after our eternal transfer (Heaven). Therefore, with excitement and great emotions, we tender our resignation as of December 31st, 2022, to make room for Todd and Dana Childers.

All of this will enable me to work behind the scenes and still be active in missions.

Candy and I thank you—our directors, volunteer teams, and donors for the sacrifices made for the ministry. MLI has indeed been a joint effort. I am confident you will support our new Executive Director as much as you have supported me. **To God be the GLORY!**



- O **WIDOW EARTH-BAG HOME PROJECT**: This unique project is for providing a home to a widow in need that owns land or is provided. The cost is set at **\$4,500** per build.
- O **MEDICAL FUND**: Our Medical Fund helped several Ugandans during December. One was pastor Waswa's wife, who survived a cobra bite. <u>Praise the LORD</u> for His mercy and those that gave towards this very important fund. <u>ANY AMOUNT IS APPRECIATED</u> as we are contacted daily from multiple sources to help many during their time of suffering and illness.
- O MISSION TRIP ASSISTANCE: MLI plans to conduct two trips in 2023, Uganda in Feb and Kenya in June. Any donations given to this area helps to offset the costs of future trips due to rising fuel prices globally. This fund allows MLI to offer scholarships for those needing help to "GO On Mission" and to witness GOD at work in Africa.
- O STREET KID FUND: Many in the USA cannot imagine children (7-8 yrs old) living on the street. However, in many third world countries this is normal.
