Peace in the Storm Where is your shelter?

Though the world appears to be falling apart, the goal remains the same. To preach the gospel to all creation, made after the image of God, to be reconciled to our Creator and Lord (Mark 16:15; 2 Cor. 5:18-20). It may seem easy to become absorbed by all the breaking news that targets our emotions. However, let us remain calm by allowing the Bible and the Holy Spirit of God to bring peace amid the storm.

The Lord Jesus never placed any circumstantial stipulations upon our obedience to His commandments. The only conditional statement made by the Lord Jesus in connection with His commandments helps to

differentiate between those who say they love Him and those who show their love for Him. As recorded in the Fourteenth Chapter of the Gospel of John, Jesus spoke *several* conditional statements regarding those who love Him. It would do us good to recall a few of them here:

John 14:15-17 (NKJV) "**If you love Me, keep My commandments**. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you."

John 14:21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

John 14:23-24 Jesus answered and said to him, "**If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word**; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. 24 He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me."

It is imperative to know that in all of scripture, The Lord never repeats Himself by accident, and all should take heed at the times He does. Nevertheless, Jesus knew being obedient would not be easy, and that is why He explained the Holy Spirit was being sent as a "Comforter, Helper, Teacher, etc." He then stated, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." (John 14:27) Jesus taught His disciples great truths that most of them lived out after the Holy Spirit indwelled them after Pentecost. Several of their letters to the churches included the importance of applying faith that brings about obedience to the Lord.

Our mission teams often travel by boat to visit the islands of Lake Victoria in Uganda. The Lord has been gracious to us with mostly good weather. However, we have experienced rough waves, wind, and heavy rains from a storm. Life is like being at sea. Some days, we may live through calm and peaceful seas, and other days, we focus on the waves caused by a storm around us. The situation today may seem as it did to Jesus' disciples on that day, when in the evening, they were crossing the Sea of Galilee, and a great tempest (windstorm) arose, causing the waves to rise and enter the boat. Panicked, the disciples found the Lord Jesus in the rear of the ship, asleep on a pillow, and awoke Him to beg for His help. Jesus merely rose and rebuked the wind and waves by commanding them to "Be still!" He then asked them, "Where was their faith?" (Mark 4:35-41). We, too, need to be reminded often that our only trust should be in Jesus continually, who is our salvation and refuge (Psa. 62:8). This brings peace during the toughest storms.

We at Mission LINK have been called to "GO" and do our part of fulfilling the Great Commission. Our call happens to be in Uganda, Kenya, and wherever else the Lord opens for us a door. Thank you for supporting us in remaining focused on King Jesus, heaven, and sharing the ONLY redeeming message of salvation through Jesus Christ alone.

MLI CHRISTIAN STUDY CENTERS: Our #1 objective is to make disciples that make disciples. Donations to MLI helps us to continue this work.


MEDICAL FUND: Gifts to this fund helps us care for the sick that lack the means to seek medical attention.
