A Rekindled LOVE for the LORD in 2026

As I awakened this frigid December morning, I went to stoke the remaining hot coals in our wood stove to create more heat. However, simply stirring around through the ashes to uncover hot embers will not produce the desired outcome. In fact, at that point, there was no longer a flame, only a few hot coals. I had to add some fuel, a mixture of newspaper and cardboard, to those hot spots and then top it off with some dry wood before the flames ignited and started spreading throughout the stove. Fires eventually die out once they have burned up all their fuel or starved of oxygen. The process of rekindling the fire within the stove is similar to how believers must continuously feed their spiritual fire, not in a legalistic or religious formula, but by any means that keeps us close to GOD. This includes: devotion/meditation time in the Holy Scriptures, fasting, praying, singing, worshipping (individually and corporately), etc.



The Apostle Paul gave these instructions to young Timothy:

1 Timothy 4:14-16 (NKJV) "Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you."

Imagine: as Children of GOD, we are called to keep fanning the flames so others will witness our lives of faith and can then "hear" the gospel and have the opportunity to be saved.

First, The Transformational Change: Rebirth (Born-Again)

The gospel of Jesus Christ calls every believer to a radical transformation—to become entirely new people who exhibit godly behaviors and live wholly for the Lord. This profound change is not a mere improvement of our old selves but a complete renewal, rooted in the sacrificial love of Christ and empowered by the indwelling Holy Spirit. As Paul declares in Galatians 2:20: "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." This verse captures the essence of the Christian life: our old self dies with Christ on the cross, and we rise to live not for ourselves, but through His life within us.

The Apostle Paul echoed this truth in 2 Corinthians 5:17: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new." The moment we place our faith in Jesus, the old patterns of sin, selfishness, and separation from God pass away. We are reborn with a new nature, oriented toward righteousness and holiness. This new life manifests in godly behaviors—love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control—as the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). No longer driven by fleshly desires, we pursue what pleases the Lord, reflecting His character in our thoughts, words, and actions.

We live this way because Christ "loved me and gave himself for me." His death was not abstract; it was personal, substituting Himself for our sins so we could be reconciled to God. In response, we surrender our lives totally to Him, living not for personal ambition or worldly approval, but for His glory. This total devotion means allowing the Holy Spirit to lead us daily. When Christ lives in us through the Spirit, obedience to God's will flows naturally. It is no longer a burdensome duty but a joyful response to His indwelling presence. The Spirit convicts, guides, and empowers us, making godly living the organic outgrowth of our union with Christ, rather than forced effort.

In essence, the call to become new and renewed people is for all believers. Over time, flames tend to die down as we starve them by quenching the Spirit of God through neglecting quality time with JESUS. Nevertheless, there is Good News. All is not lost. Return to Him and commit your life to drawing closer starting today. Through faith, we die to self and rise with Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit to live fully for the One who gave everything for us. This transformed life honors His sacrifice and displays the beauty of the gospel to the world. Let us echo the words of John the Baptist, "He must increase, but I must decrease." (John 3:30)

I pray for each of you to have a BLESSED New Year in 2026 and that Christ would be magnified in our lives for His glory.
