Alive in Christ

his world sets its hooks in us early in life, appealing to our sinful nature, which is fleshly. Adults often criticize young toddlers for crying whenever they do not get what they want, even if it would be harmful. Have you ever considered that this is how God must look at us when things do not go our way? Somehow, we are deceived into believing we have either lost a blessing or are no longer favored by God when our happiness does not increase. The deception is real and affects all of us. No one is immune to having personal pity parties, no matter our age.

God's word explains everything we need to know regarding how and why adults continue acting like children throwing tantrums. "The Fall" of man, as recorded in Genesis 3, illustrates how temptations lure us away from what our Lord has forbidden. The deceptions from this world will only increase as we continue to approach the day when our Lord returns. The Apostle John warned us how this world and its ruler entices us with great details.

"For all that is in the world—the **lust of the flesh**, the **lust of the eyes**, and the **pride of life**—is not of the Father but is of the world." (1 John 2:16)

Many believe this is how Satan deceived Eve as he drew her attention to the appearance of the tree, its fruit, and its ability to give wisdom (Gen. 3:6). Once both Adam and Eve disobeyed God, their fellowship with Him was broken. Spiritual death had occurred. The Apostle Paul explained how this pattern continues within us today. "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned." (Rom. 5:12). Those times we break fellowship with the Lord we are leaving ourselves open for continual deception by God's enemy. We must seek restoration at once.

So then, how can we LIVE pleasing to God? I'm glad you asked.

Not only does the Apostle Paul explain how Paradise was lost, but he also sheds light on how we can regain it. "For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive." (1 Cor. 15:22) Paradise is not defined as a world that lacks problems, conflicts, sickness, sorrow, or even death. True Paradise is where the Lord Jesus is present, and all of God's children (reborn by His spirit) will live for all eternity. The Lord Jesus conquered death itself so that we may LIVE in Him. "For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life." (Rom. 5:10)

Becoming **ALIVE in CHRIST** occurs when one sinner comes to God, confessing their sins and submitting their lives under the Lordship of Christ. While acknowledging Jesus as Lord begins the regeneration process (John 1:12-13; Rom. 10:9-10), submission is where God's Spirit takes control, quickening our mortal bodies and leading us on the path of redemption (John 3:3; Rom. 8:11; James 4:8). "Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice," (1 Sam. 15:22b).

The Lord Jesus told His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it." (Mat. 16:24-25) Taking up our cross is the act of dying to self completely.

Submitting to God <u>cannot</u> be done halfway. If someone does not fully submit, then it is not a submission at all. Much like the sport of wrestling, the match continues only until an opponent fully submits. We only fool ourselves if we think we can partially submit to God, believing that we gain His favor and blessing by attending church services without living by faith for the rest of our time on earth.

Full Submission:

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but **Christ lives in me**; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." (Gal. 2:20)

The only way to Live pleasing to God is to be dead to self and Alive in Christ, fully submitted to God's will and following His lead. My prayer is that everyone reading this can identify as a Child of God, having experienced an internal change that affects our outward actions. Let us submit fully to the Lord Jesus and produce much fruit for the kingdom, drawing others to heaven with us.
